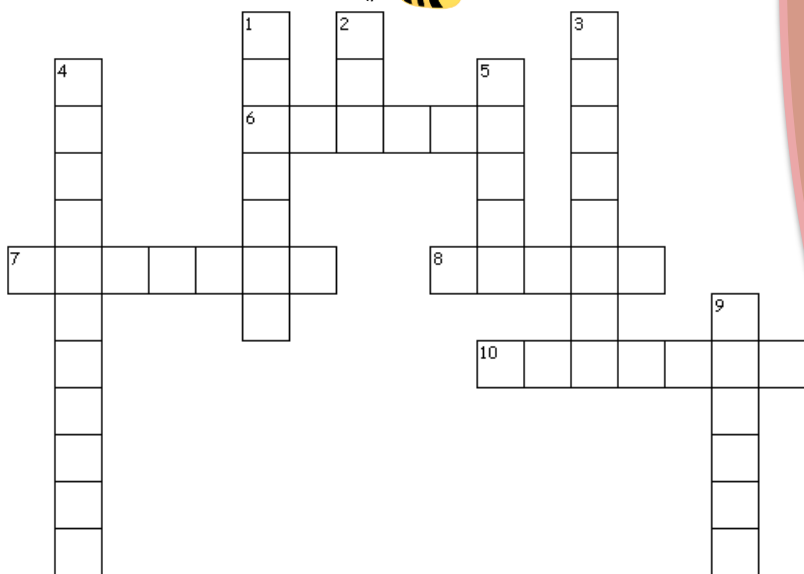

- 10. Pheromone released by worker bees to attract foragers back to the hive

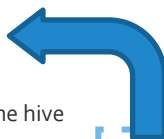
Down
